Quality framework of the European Higher Education Area (EHEA)



ECTS	common credit system, based on learning outcomes and student workload
QF-EHEA	qualifications framework, specifies learning outcomes and ECTS credit ranges for the short/Ba/Ma/PhD cycles
ESG	common standards for internal and external quality assurance (QA)
EQAR	official register of agencies that substantially comply with ESG
DEQAR	higher education institutions & programmes quality-assured in line with ESG

“quality at your fingertips”



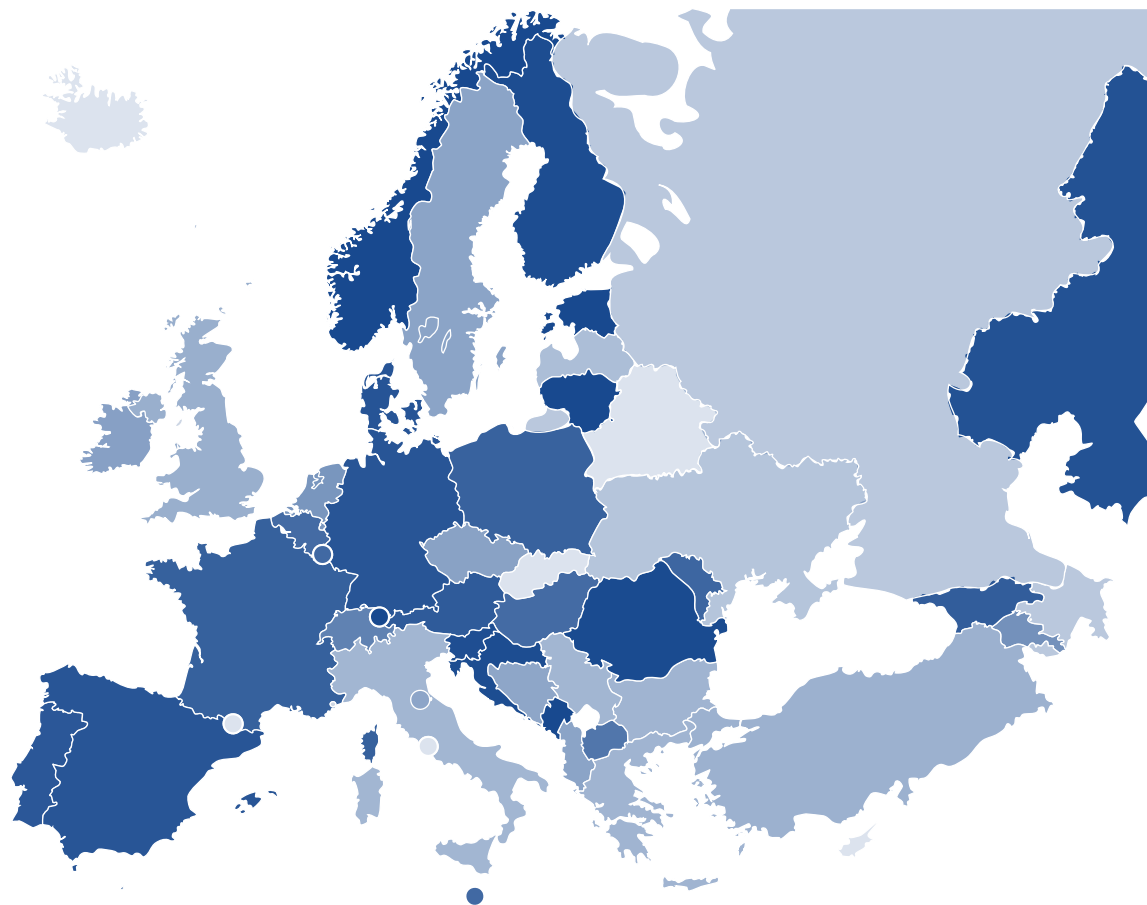

- Easy access to external quality assurance (QA) reports and decisions by EQAR-registered agencies
- Enhance **transparency and visibility at the European level**
- **Facilitates trust and automatic recognition**, based on robust quality assurance in line with ESG
- **Responds to information needs** of various stakeholders, in particular ENIC-NARICs and admission officers

DEQAR CONNECT: integration with ENIC-NARICs



- Goal:
 - integrate automatic search in DEQAR
 - directly part of a centre's own application/digital workflow
 - simplify check of QA/accreditation status
- Four centres involved:
 - Italy: CIMEA
 - France Education International
 - Romania: CNRED
 - Netherlands: Nuffic
- Opportunities:
 - examples can be used by other centres or HEIs
 - reference in recognition documents
 - better cope with increasing diversity of providers
